

Smooth, Round Pods



León

In winter trials, León has provided the advantage of good field-holding ability and a longer harvest of smooth, round pods – the result of typically slow seed development and an upright plant that holds pods well off the ground. León combines these traits with resistance to certain races of common mosaic virus, making it an excellent bean for winter plantings in Florida and Mexico.
