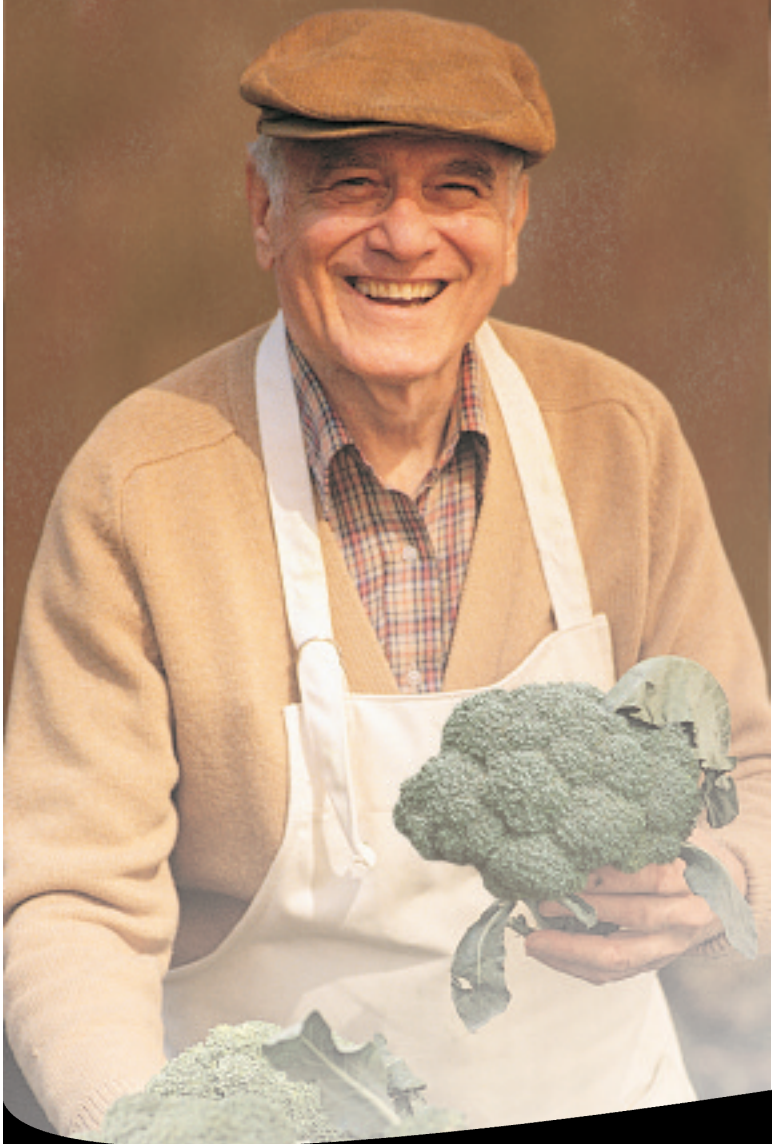




Concord



Concord has shown good adaptation to cooler production seasons and has demonstrated excellent adaptability in trials and commercial plantings in the spring and fall harvest periods in the Salinas Valley. It has also performed well in the Desert Southwest for harvest in the mid-winter period. This variety tends to develop solid heads that carry very good weight with versatile use. Growers have used Concord for crown, bunch and florets.
